MPRES recommends a 'blended' model of professional development that includes:

- A semester-long online course that utilizes the MPRES
 Toolkit and other online learning resources;
- Monthly <u>Professional Learning Community</u> (PLC) meetings within your school, district, or region;
- Four face-to-face workshops during the academic year.

After completing MPRES Professional Development Option 1, participants will be engaged in their own classrooms with lessons and materials adapted to the <u>Next Generation Science Standards</u> (NGSS) and an understanding of the <u>three dimensions of successful science teaching</u> as described in the National Research Council's (NRC) <u>Framework for K-12 Science Education</u>.

Research has shown that, to be the most effective, professional development should be long-term, incorporate reflective practice (such as through PLCs), and utilize multiple strategies to create the most significant learning opportunities.

For teachers or school districts that cannot accommodate this
